Scholarships will be awarded to qualified African American MBA students enrolled in an accredited (AACSB or SACS) **full-time OR part-time** graduate business program in the U.S. **Applications must be postmarked by October 15, 2016.**

Eligibility Requirements:

The South Florida NMBBAA Jacki Tuckfield MBA Scholarship Program seeks to identify African-American students who will make significant contributions in the field of business both in the public and private sectors. Applicants must be legal residents of Florida, demonstrate academic excellence, leadership potential and be actively involved in their communities through service to others.

Each year a Florida resident student will receive a scholarship award of \$1,000 (minimum)

To be eligible, applicants must:

- Be enrolled in a full-time graduate business program in a college or university in the United States, accredited by the AACSB or SACS at the time of award (September, 2016).
- Agree to attend a South Florida NMBBAA scholarship reception or other function.
- Be a member of the NMBBAA South Florida Chapter*

ESSAY

What has been your most meaningful leadership experience? What were some of the challenges or obstacles you faced? What lessons did you take away from that experience? (Essays should be approximately 500 words)

Essays must include a cover page with the essay title. DO NOT include your name on the cover page or anywhere in the essay document. Essays are reviewed "blind."

RESUME

Resumes **must not** exceed 2 pages.

TRANSCRIPT(S)
