Scholarship Description

Rules

- 2) Current transcripts to show academic standing and NSU cumulative GPA of at least 3.5.
- 3) Current résumé
- 4) Supporting documents to indicate academic awards and scholarly accomplishments (including research projects, conference presentations, etc.).
- 5) Supporting documents to indicate community and professional engagement in the advancement of the Business Intelligence/Analytics discipline (for example, actively participating in student organizations, serving as student officer in student organizations, service to community and NSU corporate partners, accomplishments in the organization where employed, etc.).
