- 40–49 credits depending on undergraduate coursework
- 24 months and a practicum
- Program begins five times annually with starts in January, March, May, August, and October.

- Complex Health Systems courses are offered alternating Saturdays over a 16-week full semester at the Fort Lauderdale/Davie Campus.

M.B.A. with a concentration in Complex Health Systems

The M.B.A. in Complex Health Systems is like no other M.B.A. currently in existence. As our health care system continues to transform and we move beyond the walls of just hospitals, this program will provide a comprehensive, flexible, transdisciplinary, and team-based learning environment, exposing our students to the full continuum of our health care system, including translational research and economic development.

The program emphasizes an experiential learning environment in the classroom, hospitals, clinics, and research settings including a final practicum course to apply the learnings. Much of this education will take place at NSU's Fort Lauderdale/Davie Campus, at clinics, multiple health care entities, and at the university's innovative Center for Collaborative Research (CCR). At the CCR, high-level relationships with incubator and early-stage health care businesses, biotech, and pharma will provide the foundation for the program.

The M.B.A. in Complex Health Systems focuses on the new business of health—the intersection of technology, research, and innovation to provide business solutions that take discoveries from the laboratory bench through the complex journey to the patient's bedside.
